



JORDAN

March 19-23 • \$1,297*

March 19 & 20 - Depart the USA & Arrive in Jordan

Your pilgrimage begins as you depart Atlanta on an overnight flight. Once you arrive, you will be welcomed at the Amman airport by our representative and transferred to your hotel in Madaba to enjoy dinner and a good night's rest.

March 21 – Madaba, Mount Nebo, Baptismal Site, King's Highway Start your journey in **Madaba**, the City of Mosaics, to visit the Church of Saint George with its sixth-century, Byzantine, mosaic map showing Jerusalem and other holy sites. Journey on to Mount Nebo, where Moses caught a glimpse of the Promised Land (Deuteronomy 34). On a clear day, you can see all the way across the Jordan Valley and the Dead Sea, to the rooftops of Jerusalem and Bethlehem. From there, head west to Al-Maghtas, the Baptismal Site on the Jordan River where it is believed that Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist. Travel the King's Highway, the famed ancient trade route that connected Egypt with Mesopotamia. Reflect on the experience of Moses being denied passage along this route by the King of Edom during the Exodus from Egypt (Numbers 20). Arrive at your hotel in Wadi Musa for dinner and overnight.

March 22 – Petra, Aqaba, Border Crossing into Israel

Visit the famous city of Petra. Dating to around 300 BC, it was the capital of the Nabatean Kingdom. Its entrance passes through a long, narrow gorge known as the Siq and can only be accessed by carriage, horseback or on foot. Once inside the city, marvel at the intricate

detail of a city that was cut into the cliff sides of rose-colored rock. At the northern edge of the Red Sea is the Gulf of Aqaba. At its northern edge, visit the port city of Aqaba, famous for its lush gardens, its coral reefs and a fortress built by the Crusaders in the 12th-century. Experience the crossing of the highly secure border into Israel. Head to your hotel in Eilat, Israel for dinner and a good night's rest.

March 23 - Underwater Observatory, Timnah Park, Maktesh Ramon, Air Force Museum Camp

Explore the fascinating Underwater Observatory in Eilat before heading north to Timnah Park where you'll find the world's oldest copper mine, continuously mined since time of King Solomon. See very unusual stone formations as well as a life-size replica of the original Tabernacle. Head to Maktesh Ramon, the world's largest "erosion cirque," a geological feature of Israel's Negev desert located at the peak of Mount Negev. Finish your day of exploring with a stop at the Air Force Museum Camp, just outside Be'er Sheva. See the amazing collection of aircraft that have helped keep Israel safe from its many enemies. Head to your hotel in Jerusalem where you will join the rest of your arriving tour guests for dinner and overnight before continuing your tour.

March 22 & 23 - Depart & Arrive in the Holy Land

Your pilgrimage begins as you depart Atlanta on an overnight flight. Once you arrive, you will be welcomed at the Tel Aviv airport by our representative and transferred to your hotel in Jerusalem to enjoy dinner and a good night's rest.

March 24 – Israel Museum, Shrine of the Book, Yad Vashem, Mount of Olives

Explore the **Israel Museum** and its First Century Model of the City of Jerusalem. Another highlight is the museum's **Shrine of the Book** exhibit showcasing the Dead Sea Scroll book of Isaiah. Visit **Yad Vashem**, Israel's Holocaust Memorial, with its poignant exhibits honoring the lives lost during the Holocaust. Spend some time browsing the shops along **Mahane Yehuda Shuk** and enjoy lunch at one of the intriguing sidewalk cafes. **Tour the Old City** and walk along the Cardo, the ancient main street. Enjoy the sunset **overlooking the Mount of Olives** then return to your hotel for dinner and a restful evening.

March 25 – Mount of Olives, Gethsemane, Garden Tomb, Herod's Palace

Visit the Herodium, the site of **King Herod's Palace** and burial tomb. Stand on the **Mount of Olives** as Jesus did, and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem, including the Temple Mount and Dome of the Rock. Visit the **Garden of Gethsemane**, where Jesus prayed for God's will to be done (Matthew 26:36-39). Visit the **Garden Tomb** and meditate on Christ's glorious resurrection. Then step back into the 21st century as you drive by the **United States Embassy**. End your afternoon relaxing at the **Walter and Elise Hass Promenade**.

March 26 – City of David, Hezekiah's Tunnel, Kotel, David's Tower Museum

Discover the magic of Ancient Jerusalem as you explore the **City of David**. Visit the **Kotel** and go spelunking through Hezekiah's Tunnels and the Rabbi's Tunnels. Visit the **Temple Institute** then enjoy











some free time to explore before visiting **David's Tower Museum**.

March 27 - Genesis Land, Qumran, Dead Sea

Sojourn into the Judean Desert, back in time to **Genesis Land**, where you will experience the Land of Israel as it was during Biblical times. Take in a shepherding or pita making workshop or take your first camel ride. Stop in **Qumran**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered in 1947 by a Bedouin shepherd. Learn about the mysterious community of the Essenes who once lived on the shores of the Dead Sea. Lunch will be at the Taj Mahal Restaurant at Ein Bokek near the Dead Sea. Journey on to the Dead Sea Resort, where you will relax and spend the night.

March 28 – Leisure at the Dead Sea, Masada, Ein Gedi Enjoy a relaxing morning at the Dead Sea, the lowest spot on earth. Take a dip in the mineral-laden waters. Regroup and head to Masada, the spectacular mountaintop fortress built by Herod that later became the final tragic stronghold of the Jewish rebellion against the Romans. Ride the cable car to the top to explore the fortress and look down upon the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. Journey on to Ein Gedi, where David hid in caves from King Saul and where he refreshed himself in the cool spring waters in the heart of the desert. Head north to the Galilee region for dinner and rest from a long day's journey.

March 29 – Galilee, Boat Ride, Capernaum, Bethsaida, Jordan River

Worship as you sail from Tiberias across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum, the center of Jesus' Galilean ministry. Visit Bethsaida, the hometown of Peter, James, and Andrew near where the blind man received his sight and where Jesus fed thousands with just 5 loaves and two fishes. Head south to Yardenit and participate in a Baptismal service in the Jordan River.

March 30 – Har Megiddo, Ma'ayan Harod National Park. Beit She'an

Visit Har Megiddo (Gr.>Armageddon) to view one of the most important archaeological sites in Israel. Destroyed by Pharaoh Shishak in 926 BC, rebuilt by Israel's King Ahab, then later used to stable King Solomon's horses, it is here that Revelation tells us many nations will come together in mankind's final battle. Journey on to Mount Gilboa and visit Ma'ayan Harod National Park, where you'll find the spring God used to sift Gideon's Army down to the 300 men who would face the Midianites. Discover the magnificent ruins at Beit She'an, where 1 Samuel 31 tells us that King Saul and his three sons were hung on the walls after they were slain in battle by the Philistines.

March 31 – Safed, Golan Heights, Vista Farms, Valley of Tears Visit Safed, the highest city in the Galilee region, believed to have been a fortified city as early as the time of Josephus. It served as a refuge for rabbis, Kabbalistic scholars, and other Jews fleeing the Spanish Inquisition during the 15th-century AD. Tour the Golan Heights, known as Bashan, a city of refuge during the time of Joshua. It is also the site of the famed Six-Day War of 1967. Nearby, visit the famed Vista Farms Olive Oil & Winery and take home some samples. Stop in the Valley of Tears, the site of the Yom Kippur War of 1973.

April 1 – Tel Dan, Banias, Nimrod's Fortress, Jeep Ride by the Sea of Galilee

At the ruins of Tel Dan, see the altar built by King Jeroboam I (I Kings 12:25-30) and learn about where the "House of David" fragment from the First Temple Period was discovered. Enjoy the stunning scenery around the Nature Reserve at **Banias** and see Israel's tallest waterfall. Situated on the southern slopes of Mount Hermon, Israel's highest and only snow-capped mountain, you will encounter magnificent views from **Nimrod's Fortress** built in the middle ages for the purpose of guarding against armies coming from the west. End your day with breathtaking views of the Sea of Galilee from vantage points only accessible by Jeep!

April 2 – Nazareth (Mount Precipice), Gan HaShlosha National Park

Journey to **Nazareth**, Jesus' boyhood home (Matthew 2:23), and visit **Mount Precipice**, where Jesus miraculously escaped being thrown from the cliff after the rejection of His Sabbath day reading and teaching in the synagogue (Luke 4). Enjoy a picnic and a relaxing afternoon at the magnificent **Gan HaShlosha National Park**, a virtual Eden-like natural paradise with refreshing springs and beautiful waterfalls.

April 3 – Clandestine Museum, Haifa, Mount Carmel, Caesarea Maritima

Journey to the port city of Haifa to explore immaculately landscaped terraces and the German Colony with shops, galleries, and restaurants in 19th-century buildings. Visit the Clandestine Immigration and Naval Museum and explore the technical and maritime history of Israel. Stop off at Baha'i Overlook before journeying to nearby Mount Carmel, where Elijah confronted the Prophets of Baal (1Kings 18). Visit the ruins at the ancient city of Caesarea Maritima, home of Philip the Evangelist, Cornelius, the first Roman convert, and where Paul was imprisoned for more than two years. Journey on to your hotel to enjoy your final dinner in Israel and freshen up before your late-night transfer to the airport for your journey home.

April 4 – Arrive home in Atlanta
